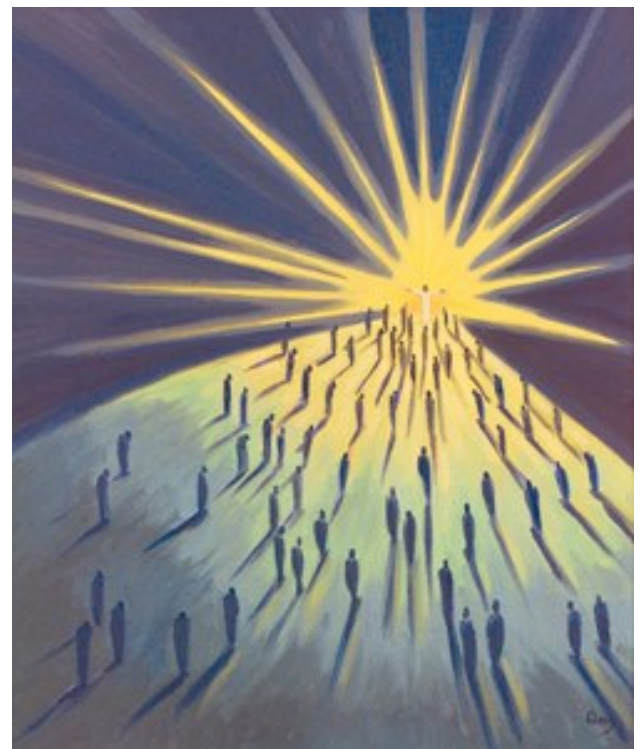
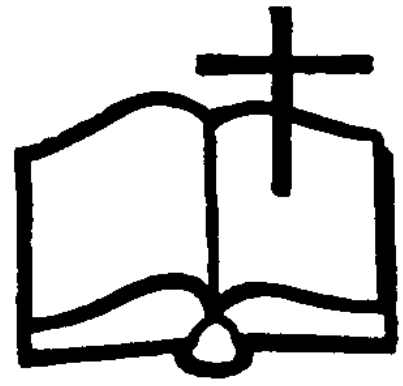


Lent 2010 - Praying the Scriptures
