

☆ **Wednesday 14th June – Mark 11:1 - 33**

- “Many people ... began to shout, “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” (v.8-9).
- When you're part of the crowd at the Cathedral singing and praising God it's often easier to believe in Jesus. Pray: *Lord Jesus, thank you for the gift of the Church community. Help us to encourage each other to say “yes” to the Lord and His will in our lives.*

☆ **Thursday 15th June – Mark 12: 1 - 44**

- “... you shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul with all your mind and with all your strength” (v.29).
- Pray the following prayer 3 times: *Holy Spirit, help me to love you with all my heart, all my mind and all my strength.*

☆ **Friday 16th June– Mark 13:1 – 37**

- “Don't let anyone mislead you” (v.5).
- Think about the people in your life who influence you. Who are the good influences and who are the bad influences?
- Pray: *Lord Jesus, thank you for the people in my life who love me. Give me the courage to follow people who will lead me closer to you.*

☆ **Saturday 17th June– Mark 14: 1 - 11**

- “... wherever the Good News is proclaimed, ... what she has done will be told in praise of her.” (v.9)
- What can you do personally to help spread the Good News, so that Jesus is known throughout the 'whole world'?

☆ **Sunday 18th June – Mark 14: 12 - 42**

- “Couldn't you stay awake for one hour?” (v.37)
- How much time will you give to Jesus? How about starting off with 5 minutes every day? Try 5 minutes every day between now and Wednesday.

☆ **Monday 19th June – Mark 14: 43 - 72**

- “I don't know the man you are talking about.” (v.71)
- Have you ever denied Jesus by either saying you 'don't believe in all that God stuff' or by not telling your friends that you've been to Church or a prayer group? Pray: *Lord, may I never deny you.*

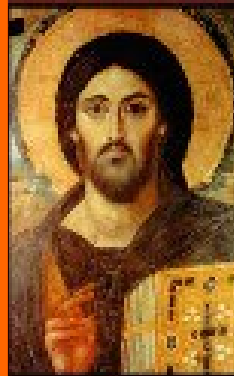
☆ **Tuesday 20th June – Mark 15: 1 - 47**

- Imagine you are stood at the foot of the Cross with Mary and the few disciples who stuck around.
- What is it that you want to say to Jesus as you see Him dying in front of you ... dying for you?

☆ **Wednesday 21st June – Mark 16: 1 – 20**

- “Go out to the whole world and proclaim the Good News to all creation.
- How will you take up the challenge given by Jesus in this passage?

Read Mark's

Revelation

“Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord God, the Almighty; who was and is and is to come.”

Read Mark's Gospel In Less Than A Month

Read the passage for the day (see in the reference in red). Then read the bullet points. These will help you to reflect on the passage you have just read.

☆ **Wednesday 31st May – Mark 1:1 – 13**

- Reflect on the verse, "You are my Son, the Beloved, the One I have chosen" (Mark 1: 11).
- Imagine God the Father speaking these words to you, for example, 'Anna, you are my daughter, the Beloved, the One I have chosen'.

☆ **Thursday 1st June – Mark 1:14 - 20**

- Jesus says in this passage, "Change your ways..." (v.15).
- If Jesus said this to you, what is it in your life that He might want you to change?

☆ **Friday 2nd June – Mark 1:21 - 45**

- "Jesus healed many who had various diseases," (v.34)
- Pray for people you know who are ill. Ask God to heal them.

☆ **Saturday 3rd June – Mark 2: 1 - 27**

- "Follow me" (v.14)
- Think about the fact that Jesus asks you to follow Him. You don't know where He might lead you but pray that you will be able to trust Him.
- Pray: *Lord Jesus, I will follow you. Help me to trust in you. I pray that you will lead me closer to our Father in heaven.*

☆ **Sunday 4th June – Mark 3: 1 - 35**

- "All of them were astonished and praised God ..." (v.12).
- What would it take for you to be astonished? Do you believe that miracles happen today? Pray for an increase in your faith.

☆ **Monday 5th June – Mark 4: 1 - 20**

- "Listen then, if you have ears" (v.9).
- Do you take time in your day to listen to God?
- Think of a time in your day when you can spend a few moments talking to God (perhaps on your journey to school or while you're drying your hair, or maybe before you go to bed) and commit to saying an Our Father at that time for the next week.

☆ **Tuesday 6th June – Mark 4: 21 - 41**

- Read again the passage about Jesus calming the storm (Mark 4: 35 – 41).
- What are you frightened of?
- Offer your fears to Jesus. Pray: *Come Holy Spirit of peace, take away my fears and fill me with your peace.*

☆ **Wednesday 7th June – Mark 5: 1 - 43**

- "...your faith has saved you..." (v.34)
- Pray the following prayer: *Lord Jesus, thank you for dying for me on the Cross. Send your Holy Spirit to fill my heart with love for you. May I never forget that your death and resurrection means that I can have eternal life.*

☆ **Thursday 8th June – Mark 6: 1 – 56**

- "Courage! It's me; don't be afraid" (v.50)
- Did you know that the phrase "Do not be afraid" appears in the Bible 365 times, one for each day of the year!

☆ **Friday 9th June – Mark 7: 1 – 37**

- "He has done all things well" (v. 37)
- Reflect on the good things that God has given you, your friends and your family. Thank God for these things.

☆ **Saturday 10th June – Mark 8: 1 – 38**

- "Who do you say I am?" (v.29)
- Who is Jesus is for you? Which name for Jesus do you use in prayer, for example, friend, saviour, king, brother, Lord?

☆ **Sunday 11th June – Mark 9: 1- 13**

- "...listen to him" (v.7)
- Spend few minutes in silence listening out for what the Lord might be saying to you.

☆ **Monday 12th June – Mark 9: 14 - 50**

- " And if your foot makes you fall into sin, cut it off!" (v.45)
- What are the bad things in your life that you need to get rid of? (Not body parts! Think about the attitudes, bad language or sinful behaviour that separates you from God).

☆ **Tuesday 13th June – Mark 10: 1 – 52**

- "Let the children come to me and don't stop them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these" (v.14).
- As young people we are called to be close to the Lord. He desires to spend time with us. Pray: *Lord Jesus increase my desire to spend time with you.*
