May this day of celebration, in which it is customary to enjoy some leisure and gratuitousness, help us to experience Jesus' presence. Let us ask the Virgin Mary that our hands may be filled with the gifts of the peace and serenity of the Risen One, so as to share them with our brothers and sisters, especially those who have greater need of comfort and hope."
