

"The fourth Sunday of Easter, which we celebrate today, is dedicated to Jesus the Good Shepherd. The Gospel says that: "The sheep *hear his voice*, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out" (Jn 10:3). The Lord calls us by name, He calls us because he loves us. However, the Gospel says, there are *other voices*, that are not to be followed: those of strangers, thieves and brigands who mean harm to the sheep. There is the voice of God, who speaks kindly to the conscience, and there is the tempting voice that leads to evil. One can learn to discern these two voices: they speak two different languages, that is, they have opposite ways of knocking on [the door of] our hearts. Just as we know how to distinguish one language from another, we can also distinguish the voice of God from the voice of the evil one....Today we celebrate World Day of Prayer for Vocations. Christian life is always a response to God's call, in any living condition. This Day reminds us of what Jesus said one day, that the field of the Kingdom of God requires much work, and we must pray the Father to send labourers to work in his harvest (cf. Mt 9:37-38). I invite everyone to invoke the Lord for the gift of good workers for his Kingdom, with a heart and hands that are open to his love". (Pope Francis, Regina Caeli, 2020)
