

## CHURCH OF THE HOLY ROSARY





SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME – 12<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2023

"Today's Gospel reading (cf. Mt 5:17-37) is on the "Sermon on the Mount" and deals with the subject of the fulfilment of the Law: how should I fulfil the Law, how can I do it? Jesus wants to help his listeners take the right approach to the prescriptions of the Commandments given to Moses, urging them to be open to God who teaches us true freedom and responsibility through the Law. It is a matter of living it as an instrument of freedom. Let us not forget this: to live the Law as an instrument of freedom, which helps me to be freer, which helps me not to be a slave to passion and sin. Let us think about war, let us think about the consequences of war...So many calamities, so many. This is the result of passion, and people who wage war do not know how to master their passions. They do not comply with the law. When one gives in to temptation and passion, one is not the master and agent of one's own life, but rather one becomes incapable of managing it with willingness and responsibility. Today Jesus asks us to continue on the path of love that he has indicated to us and which begins from the heart. This is the path to follow in order to live as Christians. May the Virgin Mary help us to follow the path traced by her Son, to reach true joy and to spread justice and peace everywhere." (Pope Francis, Angelus, 2020).
