Operating Loss £54,213

We are very grateful that our Offertory Income has increased by just under £30,000 in the year, but unfortunately our bills have also increased. For example, in total, gas, electricity and water have gone up by just over £40,000.

During the year we also received £44,049 from specific fundraising, £22,309 from legacies, and £140,046 grant income for future projects.



Update on Major Projects (June 2023)

Holy Rosary Community Room £133,374 raised of a target of £205,000. We are awaiting outcomes of several more grant applications but are hopeful work will be completed by Autumn 2023.

Cathedral Building Fund - £135,725 raised of a target of £140,000. Shortfall £4,275. Work still to fund includes cleaning of the floor and replacement of more LED lamps.

Bentley Pulpit - £15,866 - Now fully funded!

In June 2023 the Cathedral was awarded £99,944 by The National Lottery Heritage Fund. This will fund further masonry repairs, enable the development of resources for school visits, offer training opportunities for volunteers and much more including a study of how to improve access and toilet facilities at the Cathedral.
