## MAX THE MONKEY, CROCHET PATTERN

Max's head and body, muzzle, arms, legs and tail are made using Amigurumi crochet method, so do not join each round. Use a marker in last stitch and continue to move marker up as you finish a row and start the next. Instructions are in British English


REQUIREMENTS:
Yarn: 100\% cotton or wool blend.
Dark Blue: 50g,
Gold/Ginger: 100g,
White: 50g,
Dark Brown: 20g,
Black: small amount for facial features
Hook: 3mm for DK.

## Stitch Markers.

Tapestry Needle for sewing parts together.

## ABBREVIATIONS:

MC - Magic circ
ch - Chain
sst - Slip Stitch
dc - Double crochet
tr - Triple crochet
Inc- 2dc into 1 stitch (increase)
Dec - dc2 tog. (decrease)

## EYES: Make 2-BLUE

1. Ch 4

TURN,
2. $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into $1^{\text {st }}$ chain and next 2 chains, 6 dc into end chain, 1 dc into next 3 ch . TURN, (12dc)
(you are working both sides of the beginning chains.)
3. $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $4 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, *repeat into next 3 dc 's, 1 dc into next 4 dc . TURN, (16dc)
4. $1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $5 \mathrm{dc},{ }^{*} 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next 5 dc .

TURN, (18dc)
5. 1ch, 1 dc into next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 dc into each of next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, 1dc into next 6dc.
(22dc)

## Fasten off, leaving long piece to sew together

## PUPILS: Make 2

## With Black:

MR. 8dc into ring. Join to 1 st dc. with sst.

## Change to White.

$2 d c$ into each dc (16dc) Sst to first dc. Fasten off.

Sew pupils to centre of each eye piece. Join eye pieces together side by side from flat edge for four sts.

## MUZZLE: BLUE

1. Ch 8,

Continue using amigurumi method, working both sides of chs.
2. Turn, $2 d c$ into first ch, $1 d c$ into next 6 ch., $6 d c$ into end ch., $1 d c$ into next dc, 4dc into first ch. (place Stitch Marker in last dc.)
(24dc)
3. $2 d c$ into first dc, 1 dc into next 8 dc , (inc) $2 d c$ into each of next 4 dc , 1 dc into next 8 dc , (inc) 2 dc into each of next 3 dc . (move marker up into last dc)
4. $2 d c$ into $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1dc into next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next 4dc. (move marker)
5. 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into next $12 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 dc into each of next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into next $12 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 dc into each of next 2dc, 1dc into next dc. (move marker)
(44dc)
6. $2 d c$ into next dc, $1 d c$ into next $14 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1dc into next $2 d c, 2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next 14dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, $1 d c$ into next $2 d c, 2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc. (move marker)
7. $2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next $16 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into next 4dc, 2dc into next dc, 1dc into next dc, 2 dc into next dc, 1 dc into next 16 dc , $2 d c$ into next dc, 1 dc into next dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, 1dc into next 4dc, $2 d c$ into next dc, $1 d c$ into next dc. Join to 1st dc.

Remove marker, Fasten off.

## MAX THE MONKEY, <br> CROCHET PATTERN

Sew eyepiece to 16 dc on one side of muzzle. Using Black, stitch mouth onto muzzle over centre chains. With Black, stitch two nostrils halfway between mouth and beginning of eyepiece, either side of join for eyes, - approx. row 4.

## HEAD AND BODY: GOLD/GINGER

1. MR (or 4 chains joined) -6 dc into ring. (Place Stitch Marker in last dc)
2. 2dc into each dc (Move Marker)
(12dc)
3. *1dc into next dc, $2 d c$ into next (18dc)
*Repeat from beginning of each row until end of round, moving marker as required.
4. *1dc into next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc.*
5. $* 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc.*
6. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc.*
7. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc.*

## (36dc)

8. *1dc into next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into next dc.*
(42dc)
9. *1dc into next 7dc, 2 dc into next dc. *
(48dc)
10. 1dc into next 7dc, 2dc into next dc.

Rows 10-21: 1 dc into each dc
22. ${ }^{*} 1 \mathrm{dc}$ into next 7dc, dc2 tog.* (Decrease rows)

## (48dc)

Mark Row 22 for placement of lower edge of eyes -i.e. where they join with muzzle.
23. *1dc into next 6dc, dc2 tog.*
(42dc)
24. *1dc into next 5dc, dc2 tog*(36dc)
25. *1dc into next 4dc, dc2 tog* ..... (30dc)
26. *1dc into next 3dc, dc2 tog* ..... (24dc)
Mark Row 26 for placement of lower edge of muzzle
27. *1dc into next 2dc, dc2 tog*(18dc)
28. 1dc into each dc(18dc)
Now STUFF the head. The following rows make the body.
29. *1dc into next 2 dc, 2 dc into next dc.* ..... (24dc)
30. 1dc into each dc round ..... (24dc)
31. *1dc into next 3dc, 2dc into next dc.* ..... (30dc)
32. *1dc into next 4dc, $2 d \mathrm{~d}$ into next dc.*(36dc)Place markers for tummy patch, 12sts apart.
33. 1dc into each dc(36dc)
34. *1dc into next 5dc, 2dc into next dc* ..... (42dc)
Rows 35-39: 1 dc into each dc ..... (42dc)
40. *1dc into next 6dc, 2 dc into next dc* ..... (48dc)
Rows 41 -46: 1dc into each dc.(48dc)
Place markers for end of Tummy Patch, in line with first markers.47. *1dc into next 6dc, dc2 tog* (To decrease)(42dc)
48. *1dc into next 5dc, dc2 tog*(36dc)
49. *1dc into next 4dc, dc2 tog*(30dc)
50. *1dc into next 3dc, dc2 tog* ..... (24dc)
51. *1dc into next $2 \mathrm{dc}, \mathrm{dc} 2$ tog*(18dc)
Now stuff the body.
52. *1dc into next dc, dc 2tog*(12dc)53. *dec 2tog*(6dc)


ARMS: Make 2.

With BLUE, ch 3 and work into both sides of chains

1. 2 dc in $1^{\text {st }} S t .1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next, 6 dc in end ch . 1 dc in $2^{\text {nd }} s t, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in $1^{\text {st }} s t$.

Rows 2-5. Dc into each st
6. Dc in first 6 sts, 5 tr into next st, dc into next 6sts.
7. Dc in next 6sts, dc 5tr tog. Dc in next 6sts
8. Dc into each st.

CHANGE to GOLD/GINGER

Rows 9-33 Dc into each st.

Fasten Off, leaving long end to sew onto BODY. Stuff lightly.
(A pipe cleaner can be inserted into each arm as you stuff, to give more flexibility)


## LEGS: Make 2

With BLUE, ch 4 and work into both sides of chains.

1. $3 d c$ in first ch, 1 dc in next 2 chs, $6 d c$ in end ch, 1 dc in next 2 chs, $3 d c$ in first ch.
2. 1 dc in each st
3. 1 dc in back loop only of each st.
4. 1 dc in each st.
5. 1 dc in next 6 sts, ${ }^{*}$ htr 2 tog, repeat from * once, 1 dc in next 6 sts
6. 1 dc in next 6 sts, htr 2 tog, 1 dc in next 6 sts.
7. 1 dc into each st.

## CHANGE COLOUR: GOLD/GINGER

Rows 8-33: 1 dc into each st round

Fasten off leaving long end to sew onto BODY. Stuff lightly.
(A pipe cleaner can be inserted into each leg as you stuff, to give more flexibility)


## TAIL: Make 1

With WHITE. Stuff tail as you go along.

1. Magic circle, 4 dc into circle
2. 1 dc in each st. (4sts)
3. 1dc in $1^{\text {st }} s t$, 2 dc in next st, Repeat. (6 sts)
4. 1 dc in each st
(6sts)
Rows 5-8: Repeat Row 4
5. 1 dc in next st. 2 dc in next st. Repeat x 2 .

Rows 10-13: 1 dc into each st
14. 1 dc in next $2 \mathrm{sts}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st, Repeat $x 2$

15 1dc in each st

## CHANGE COLOUR to DARK BROWN

Rows 16-20: 1 dc into each st.

## CHANGE to GOLD/GINGER

Rows 21-55: 1 dc into each st.

## Fasten off leaving long end of cotton to sew onto BODY



## EARS: Make 2, using BLUE

1. 3 ch
2. 2 dc in first $\mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch, 2 dc in next ch. TURN
(5sts)
3. 2 dc in first $s t, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next, 2 dc in next, 1 dc in next, 2 dc in last st.

TURN
4. 2 dc in first st, 1 dc in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in last dc. TURN
5. 2 dc in next $\mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $2 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc , (3times)

TURN
6. 2 dc in next dc, 1 dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next dc. (3times) TURN
7. 1 dc in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $6 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in next 6 dc .
(12sts)
(18sts)
(24sts)
(32sts)

Fasten off, leaving long tail to sew to HEAD.


## TUMMY PATCH

With WHITE, 13chs TURN.

1. 1 dc into each dc. 1 ch ,

TURN
(12dc)
(14dc)
(14dc)
(16dc)
(16dc)
2. $2 d c$ into first dc, 1 dc into each of next $10 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into last dc. 1 ch . Rows 3-7: 1dc into each dc, 1ch.
8. 2 dc into first dc, 1 dc into each of next $12 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ into last dc. 1 ch .

Rows 9-14: 1dc into each dc. 1ch.
TURN
TURN
TURN
TURN
Dc round edges of patch to neaten, using 3dcs in one st at each corner.


## HAIR

APPROX 3 rows from centre of eyes, attach DARK BROWN. Working one behind the other make one row towards back of head going over centre of head. Crest should end approx. 4 rows down back of head from beginning round

Sst onto head, 4ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 5ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 6ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 7ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch. - Repeat 4 times
Sst onto head, 6 ch , miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 5ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 4ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 3ch, miss first ch, dc into each ch.
Sst onto head, 2ch, 1 dc into next ch.
Dc onto head
Sst onto head
Fasten off.


## MAX THE MONKEY, CROCHET PATTERN

TO MAKE UP:


ARMS - Sew to BODY either side of neck, thumbs facing upwards.
LEGS - Sew to bottom edge of BODY, in line with arms.

TAIL - Sew to bottom edge of BODY, at back, midway between legs
EARS - Sew to side of HEAD, with top of ears level with beginning row of crest and bottom of ears level with mouth ends.

TUMMY PATCH - Sew in place on tummy, between top and bottom markers.
Remember, bottom edge is wider than top edge, but will still be in line with top edge, due to increases.
