Many children throughout the world spend their days working in the fields, collecting water or begging. A free school meal makes it possible for them to attend school.

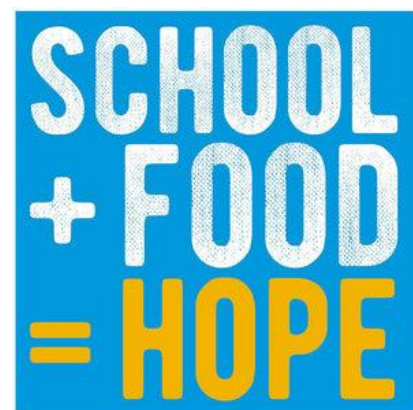
Mary's Meals feeds **2.4 million** children every school day at a cost of **£19.15** per child per year.
